Last year, 3 students from student council visited APC to express their concern. Two issues developed from the discussion: 1. Faculty Issue – websites are not matching regarding midterm feedback. The Georgia College academic affairs handbook – Faculty Work requirements – syllabus requirements – point #11 is not on the "required syllabus statements" listed on PAWS. Registrar's website matches PAWS but not our policy manual for faculty requirements. Are faculty aware of the midterm feedback requirements and if not how do we make them aware without policing? Suggestion from James Winchester – not only syllabus statements on PAWS but also faculty requirements.
