The Office of Academic Affairs is submitting the attached "Policy for the Use of Student Opinion Surveys" to the University Senate for its consideration and action. While the Office of Academic Affairs is submitting the proposal, note that Catherine Whelan, Past Presiding Officer of the University Senate, Craig Turner, Secretary of the University Senate, and Tom Ormond, Senior Associate Provost, shared in its development. The documentation provided includes the proposed policy statement and supporting information, procedures to accompany the policy (formatted in compliance with the recently adopted policy template) as well as copies of the student opinion survey entries (2002, page 7 & 2013, page 9) currently housed in the Policies, Procedures and Practices Manual (PPPM).
