 - b. "Aggregate numbers of part-time faculty are also available from the Provost by request. While GC obviously needs to take necessary steps to weather the current budgetary issues, FAPC should track trends and advocate for the values that most faculty share (i.e. valuing small class sizes taught mostly by full-time and permanent faculty) in the medium term."
