New concentrations in existing programs are passed on the USG only as an information item unless those concentrations are outside of existing degree programs. A question CAPC has for the President and/or Provost is, to what extent are these reviewed? The Liberal Studies program has submitted a proposal with several new concentrations. How will these be reviewed at the BOR?

CAPC is considering two proposals. One concerns the revision of the general education goals. There are 11 goals currently. The proposal would rename these goals to University Shared Learning Goals and reduce the number to 5, which are stated more broadly. A forum is planned for next Friday, November 18. The location and time will be announced once the space is confirmed. The second proposal concerns the revision of the Core learning outcomes. In particular, the proposal would eliminate the writing and speaking overlays. A forum is planned for Friday, November 18.
